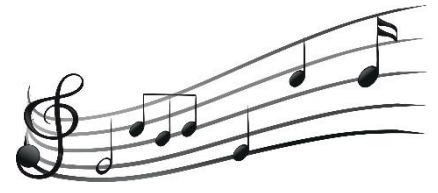




WREDLING HONOR MUSIC AND EXTRACURRICULARS 2016-2017
